*SECTION VIII VIDEOTAPING POLICY

The Section recognizes the value of videotaping opponents as an athletics teaching tool, but it also recognizes that certain general conditions to regulate videotaping should be observed section wide in order to protect student athletes and athletic departments.

Videotaping at Section VIII approved and sanctioned athletics contests are permissible. This does not include practices or scrimmages unless approved by the participating teams.

All videotaping will be used for instructional purposes to include scouting. The individual's right to privacy requires that the anonymity of the student athlete's images displayed in the product of the videotaping be maintained and protected unless expressed in written consent to share his/her identity is provided.

Videotaping of any contest may not be used in a commercial enterprise. Specific limitations, regulations, and/or requirements with regard to videotaping should be referenced and included in all sport specific handbooks.
