- D. Shot Clocks for Boys Lacrosse
  - 1. Can purchase a second remote from BSN to split your Boys Shot Clock system but must use signal two. Shot clock operators must be trained on rules for when it resets vs when time restarts.
    - a) BOYS- Every change of possession= Reset Shot Clock ....when time starts is depended on when the player with the ball enters the offensive box.
    - b) GIRLS- Reset on goal and hit a goal post for a straight 90 seconds.
  - 2. Do shot clocks have to have a horn? Boys-no, but must have an air horn on field. Girls- will find out.
  - 3. Only need 1- oppose your bench at midline.
  - 4. Request to only have shot clocks mandatory for Varsity (Boys & GIrls) this year and push JV Boys to next year.
  - 5. Request to have county wide training for schools who can send your staff and put training video on Section website.
